



Camp Leader Job Description

BLAST is not only a summer day-camp but also a leadership program. Each staff member will go through leadership training to equip them to teach campers and lead them in building life-long friendships, boost self confidence and increase problem solving skills through games, activities and Bible Study. BLAST is one camp, two locations: 1C/The Sanctuary and Camp Luther. Each week you will get scheduled to work at either one of the sites. We offer free before and after care where you are encouraged to build relationships with the campers while playing air hockey, ping pong, coloring, legos, etc.

At 8:00 the Camp Luther bus will depart with both staff and campers. Once at camp you will begin with a morning opening with fun songs and games. Then, groups will rotate stations including archery, canoeing, swimming, hiking, Bible study, and crafts. At 4:00 you will bus back to 1C where we will host after care until 5:30.

Back at 1C, we begin the day at 9:00 with an opening assembly where you can expect great music, and an even better message! Then we break off into small groups and rotate stations such as science, art, gym games, Bible study, inflatables, drift bikes, etc. We end the day with a closing assembly followed by aftercare until 5:30

- Breakfast and Lunch will be provided at both locations.
- Camp is 10 Weeks long: May 24-July 29.
 - 8 weeks at 1C, 8 weeks at Camp Luther with 6 of those weeks overlapping.
- You will be scheduled by the week: Whichever week you are available to work, you will be scheduled from 7:45-5:15 Monday through Friday.
 - You do not have to work every week but we do require you to be able to work the full week.
- Sunday evenings we gather to dive into the week's theme, activities and Bible study.
 - A meal will be provided and it is a great time to bond with fellow staff.
 - Staff assigned to 1C for the week will decorate 1C for the theme, setting the stage and preparing the rooms.
 - Staff assigned to Camp Luther for the week will prepare crafts and theme-based activities.
