



Camp Leader Job Description

BLAST is not only a summer day-camp but also a leadership program. Each staff member will go through leadership training to equip them to teach campers and lead them in building life-long friendships, boost self confidence and increase problem solving skills through games, activities and Bible Study. We offer free before and after care where you are encouraged to build relationships with the campers while playing air hockey, ping pong, coloring, legos, etc. Camp is high paced and requires staff to be actively involved in every aspect of the children's days. The amount of time spent engaged with the children will make an enormous impact on you as a leader as well as your relationship with each child.

Each week, we will have a different theme; however, a lot of the week's layout generally remains the same. We start with before care at 7:30 where you are encouraged to play games, color, lead activities and welcome the children. You will then take your group at 9:00 to the opening assembly in the gym where we will worship and start the day with the theme message. From here we move from station to station such as arts/crafts, science, gym games, inflatables, drift bikes, etc. This is where your leadership really comes in! Each station will be pre-planned but it will be up to you to prepare ahead for what you are doing. Know the games and the projects and feel free to make them your own! The day ends at 3:00 with a closing assembly and then off to aftercare until 5:30 where you have free time to go to the gyms, or just hang out in the youth lobby.

- Camp is 8 Weeks long: May 24-July 15
- Lunch, Breakfast and Snack Provided

Each Sunday evening, we will gather together to dive into the weeks' message and activities.

- A meal will be provided and it is a great time to bond with fellow staff.
- Decorate 1C for the theme, setting the stage and preparing the rooms.
- Prepare crafts and theme-based activities
- Plan for 1-2 hours
